## **NOTES**

- 1. A \$500 non-refundable deposit is required to secure a place in the course. Assistance will be provided to help raise the remainder of the non-tuition expenses for students who request it.
- 2. Under the legal liability agreements with North Park University, travel courses are only open to North Park University and Theological Seminary students, faculty, staff, and employees, Covenant pastors, their spouses, and legal offspring or registered students and faculty within ACTS. Others may enroll as visiting NPTS students and attend the course for credit or audit.
- 3. This course meets the requirements for cultural diversity elective which is required for all NPTS degree programs. This course also meets the travel requirement for the Intercultural Ministry certificate.
- 4. Priority will be given to distance learners, upper-class students who will not be able to accommodate the course at a later time in their program and students enrolled in the intercultural ministries certificate program. Enrolled students may audit only one travel course during their degree program, but may take an unlimited number of travel courses for credit.

- 5. Students on academic probation or who have unpaid tuition are not eligible for enrollment in NPTS sponsored travel courses.
- 6. This course is three semester units with corresponding tuition. Students will be responsible for in-country travel, and room and board expenses. This does not include personal expenses such as gifts, independent travel, or extra snacks. All passport, visa, and inoculation expenses must be covered by the participants.
- 7. Additional scholarship funding is available. See instructor for details.
- 8. If accepted by the instructor for a travel course, the student will be required to submit a photocopy of his/her current passport. North Park sponsored courses require additional paperwork, including an international student identity card.
