Qualifications:

- Interest in leading "Word and Wonder" children's worship (grades K-2) during 9a.m. Sunday worship;
- Openness in discussing how God is working in intern's own life;
- Ability to facilitate conversations with high school students around faith;
- Willingness to learn and try new things even if they fail!

Expectations:

- Attend Sunday worship 2x month;
- Assist in revisioning high school youth program;
- Lead/facilitate high school youth group on Wednesday evenings from 7 8:30p.m;
- Meet bi-weekly with the Director of Youth and Children's Ministry;
- Offer feedback and recommendations on intern experience so as to grow the program for future years;
- Assist in the planning and implementation of retreat opportunity(ies) for the high school group;
- Be available to lead group of high school students on a synod retreat the weekend of October 20-22, 2023, in Tinley Park, IL. Additional compensation may be available.
